## LENT AND HOLY WEEK LITURGIES 2018

**DAILYMASSES:** As regularly scheduled: Tuesday & Thursday at 8:30 AM in East Bethany and Wednesday & Friday at 8:30 AM in Pavilion

**ASH WEDNESDAY:** 8:30 AM Mass in Pavilion and 7:00 PM Mass in East Bethany.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS AT 7:00 PM:** Stations of the Cross will be held in East Bethany on Friday, Feb. 16<sup>th</sup>, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, March 16<sup>th</sup> and in Pavilion on Friday, Feb. 23<sup>rd</sup>, March 9<sup>th</sup>, March 23<sup>rd</sup>.

### **RECONCILIATION:**

The sacrament of Reconciliation will be held at the regularly scheduled time: from 3:15 to 3:45 PM at the Saturday Mass location, except for Holy Saturday when no confessions will be heard

### **PALM SUNDAY MASSES:**

In Pavilion: 4:00 PM Saturday, 8:00AM Sunday

In East Bethany: 9:45 AM Sunday {Please note the Sunday Mass is 15 minutes later}

### **HOLY WEEK TRIDUUM:**

**Holy Thursday (3/29):** 7:00PM . The Mass of the Lord's Supper in Pavilion

**Good Friday Ceremonies (3/30):** 5:00PM -Stations of the Cross in East Bethany

6:00PM -Good Friday Liturgy in East Bethany

**Holy Saturday:** 8:30 PM Easter Vigil in Pavilion {Please note: there is no 4PM Saturday Mass for Easter weekend. Also, no confessions will be heard on Holy Saturday.}

**EASTER SUNDAY MASSES** will be celebrated according to the standard of Sunday schedule.

**LENTEN REGULATIONS:** Abstinence: All Catholics who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are bound to abstain totally from meat on the following days: Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday. Fasting: All Catholics between their 18<sup>th</sup> and 59<sup>th</sup> birthday s are also bound to observe the Law of Fast on the following days. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.
