TRINITY DOME NATIONAL COLLECTION:

In 1920, a foundation stone was laid for America's Catholic Church, the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC. This great Marian Shrine exists today because of the generosity of American Catholics and clergy, the prayers of the faithful, and the hard work of the artisans and laborers who began building it nearly 100 years ago.
