TRINITY DOME NATIONAL COLLECTION: The second collection the weekend of July 15th and 16th will be for the Trinity Dome. In 1920, a foundation stone was laid for America's Catholic Church, the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC. Since then, slowly but surely work has continued on the completion of this beautiful shrine. This great Marian Shrine exists today because of the generosity of American Catholics and clergy, the prayers of the faithful, and the hard work of the artisans and laborers who began building it nearly 100 years ago. The Conference of Bishops has authorized a one-time collection to be taken in all the parishes of the United States. This collection will help offset the cost of completing the mosaic of the Trinity Dome at the Basilica. Please give as generously as you can.

PETER'S PENCE: The second collection the weekend of July 22nd and 23rd will be for Peter's Pence. The purpose of the Peter's Pence Collection is to provide the Holy Father with the financial means to respond to those who are suffering as a result of war, oppression, natural disaster, and disease.
