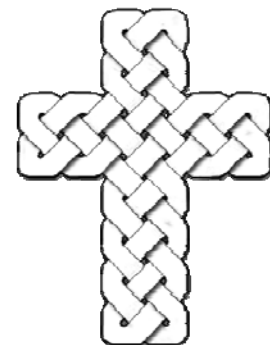

Greetings in the Lord! I pray that you and your parish community are well.

I am writing with regards to the ongoing Catholic Charities Appeal. As you know, your parish is very close to making its goal. I commend you, your parish leadership team and your parishioners for this very generous response to the Campaign! I write today to encourage you to do all you can to meet this important goal. Your encouragement and enthusiasm for the Catholic Charities campaign has a tremendous impact on its success. Please remind your parish family of the vital ministries of Catholic Charities, which serves the most vulnerable among us day in and day out. Their vital services are more comprehensive than any other human service entity within our region! For every \$50,000 by which the Appeal misses the goal, services must be cut. To operate a pantry costs \$50,000. To hire a counselor costs \$50,000. The loss of a mental health counselor means that approximately 80 teen with suicidal intentions could not be served or 80 couples with marital problems could not be given help. Let us come together to avoid this tremendous loss!

Thank you for all of the work that you have already done in this regard. Know that I will be praying for you and your parish that you can meet your goal, which is well within reach thanks to your previous efforts!
