“Say, Reverend,” said the young man, “I came here to see about getting married – but if it's going to be as much work as all that, you can count me out right now.”

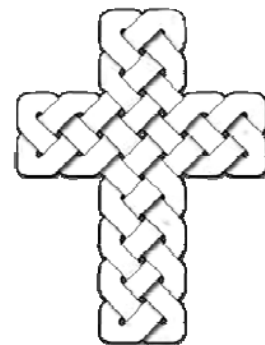

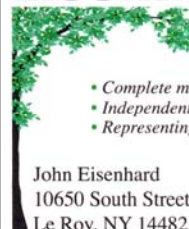
