DID YOU KNOW? In 1887 Father Thomas B. Milde was appointed as the first pastor, solely for Pavilion and it was made into an independent parish. Father Milde repaired the church and in 1887 purchased the house adjoining the church property for a rectory. The Catholic Society installed porches on their parsonage and furniture was moved in. Father Milde thanked those outside his own denomination who assisted in furnishing his house (In the same spirit of generosity given by the volunteers of Mary Immaculate who share their time and talents with the parish).
