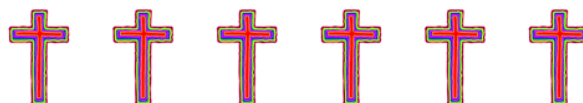
**UPCOMING RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

**WORLD YOUTH DAY CROSS:** In the summer of 2002, St. John Paul II gathered with the youth of the world in Toronto for World Youth Day. Approximately 300 participants from the Diocese of Buffalo signed a wooden cross that was used for the Stations of the Cross prayed with Bishop Mansell. In 2016, the youth of the world have been invited to join Pope Francis in Krakow, Poland for World Youth Day. Approximately 170 participants from the Diocese of Buffalo, **including our parishioner, Hannah Cline**, will travel to Poland. Many of them have already signed the outer edges of the Diocese of Buffalo World Youth Day Cross. The cross will be at our parish this weekend, **October 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>** and will travel throughout the Diocese in preparation for World Youth Day in Krakow 2016. Please pray for those who will be making the World Youth Day pilgrimage in July 2016. Also, if you or someone you know attended the Toronto World Youth Day in 2002, look for their name and pray that the spirit of World Youth Day will renew their faith.
